Introduction

This record group consists of .5 linear feet in one box. The records were given to the Manuscript Division by Dr. E. John Hamlin in August, 1982. The record group consists entirely of one folder of journals prepared by Dr. Hamlin for limited distribution in the United States. These journals are particularly relevant to the various travels and furlough periods of the Hamlins as well as relevant to their earlier years in Thailand. The reader will find a great deal of material on theological education, Thai Buddhism and Thai politics, and on the state of the Church in Thailand.

Historical Statement

Dr. Hamlin served as President of McGilvary Theological Seminary from 1956 until 1974 and was principally responsible for developing the seminary into a major institution for theological education.
