Introduction: The Papers of Charles F. Hoch consist of four notebooks and one small folder of miscellany in one box (.5 ft.). These papers came to the Manuscript Division as part of the collection of materials gathered by the Church History Research Committee of the Thailand Theological Seminary.

Charles F. Hoch worked for the American Presbyterian Mission and later for the Church of Christ in Thailand. He began his work in Phet Buri in 1925 and worked in various cities in southern Thailand including Songkla, Rat Buri, Trang, and also Nakhon Pathom. His work was mostly pastoral and evangelistic. He was married to Wan Piroshaw.

The researcher should also consult the Records of the American Presbyterian Mission (RG 001/78(a)) and the Records of District Eight, Church of Christ in Thailand (RG 021/80).
