This records group consists of .5 linear feet and 1 box. The records were given to the Manuscript Division by Herbert R. Swanson, who with his wife, Warunee, served as summer manager at Khun Tan from 1977 to 1979. This small records group includes correspondence, reservation forms, lists, finances, reports, and miscellaneous other materials. Of particular interest are notes of an oral history interview with Maa Kom Tongsawan made in 1979. The Khun Tan Cabins were first constructed beginning about 1918 or 1919 as the hot season retreat for the Lampang Station of the American Presbyterian Mission. The Khun Tan Committee which continued to run the cabins in 1979 was a vestage of the old Presbyterian Mission. However, in latter years the cabins have been made available to non-mission groups and is generally administered from Payap College. These records primarily pertain to the hot season weeks when a central dining facility was available.
